Dr. Nadine Nereson



Dr. Nadine A Nereson earned her Bachelor of Arts in Physics and Mathematics at St. Olaf College in Minnesota in 1991. In 1993, she came to the University of Washington and in 1998 earned her Doctor of Philosophy from the Geophysics Program—one of the founding partners of the combined Department of Earth and Space Sciences. She held an appointment as a Post-Doctorate Fellow in the program from 1998-2000.

Dr. Nereson was active in field research here at UW, including developing new theories to explain features of ice flow in Antarctica, where she conducted field research during three expeditions. She also represented the University of Washington in a scientist exchange program to Japan. In 1997 she was awarded the David A. Johnston Award for Research Excellence.

In 2000, she began her career with Philips Healthcare in Ultrasound Research and Development, and, in 2012 was appointed by the Philips Executive Team to lead a cross-functional focus group to study product differentiation, marketing, channel development, and cultural change strategies in the Ultrasound market. Dr. Nereson has been named to Philips Corporate "High Potential" program for General Managers. She also works to coach and mentor PhD level new hires.
